### **Grant History**

**Spring 1994 – Spring 2010**

Spring 2010

**Fishes and Loaves Food Pantry** awarded \$3,750 toward purchase of freezers and refrigeration for new building.

**Jackson County Council on Aging** awarded \$2,500 to support the Cashiers Nutrition Site.

**Hampton School** awarded \$5,000 toward an emergency fund to assist families facing financial hardship to continue early child care

**Hampton School** awarded \$12,935 towards facilities renovations to comply with NC Childcare Licensing standards.

**The Village Conservancy of Cashiers** awarded \$12,935 toward replacing the roof of the Village Green Commons facilities project.

Fall 2009

**Fishes and Loaves Food Pantry** awarded \$12,192 toward purchase of food supplies and additional refrigeration equipment to participate in MANNA's TEFAP programs along with relocation expenses for the food pantry serving Cashiers community.

**MANNA FoodBank** awarded \$3520 toward the Back Pack for Kids food program at Blue Ridge School served by the **Community Table**.

**Blue Ridge Mountain Health Project** awarded \$6,000 toward operating expenses at the free dental clinic that provides full dental services for low income and uninsured children and adults in the Cashiers- Highlands area.

**Community Care Clinic of Highlands-Cashiers** awarded \$5,000 for operating expenses including staffing, pharmacy and medical supplies for this free clinic providing primary health care for uninsured residents and workers in the Highlands-Cashiers communities.

**Animal Friends for Life** - \$5,000 to complete improvements to the Dog Annex at Forever Farm that will provide shelter for animals awaiting adoption.

**Village Conservancy** - \$10,000 toward administrative support for the Cashiers Village Council including coordination of the Pathways Initiative and other recommendations from the Cashiers Charrette in 2008.

**Village Conservancy** - \$5,000 toward the adaption for reuse of former Summit Charter School building as office and community facilities at the Village Green Commons.

Spring 2009

**Hampton Preschool and Early Learning Center** - \$5,000 toward its emergency tuition fund to assist families facing financial hardship to continue early child care.

**Jackson County Department on Aging** - \$5,000 to support the Cashiers Senior Nutrition Site.

**Community Care Clinic of Highlands-Cashiers** - \$1,668 for operating expenses including pharmacy and medical supplies for the free clinic providing health care for uninsured residents and workers in the Cashiers and Highlands communities.

**United Christian Ministries of Jackson County** - \$1,600 toward rent and utility assistance to help families in the Cashiers area remain in their homes.

Winter 2008

**Hampton School** - \$10,000 toward building renovations and program improvements at the former Cashiers Community Childcare Center.

**Cashiers United Methodist Church** - \$10,000 to the Fishes & Loaves Food Pantry to help offset food costs related to the substantial increase in community assistance provided due to the recession.

**Blue Ridge Mountains Health Project** - \$2,000 for equipment purchases, including specialized eyeglasses for the volunteer dentists.

Fall 2008

**Village Conservancy** - \$10,000 toward salary for a Planner to coordinate efforts by the Village Council to implement a Pathways system in the crossroads area and assist with other projects recommended in the Mountain Landscape Initiative Toolbox.

**Blue Ridge School** - \$7,000 to aid in the construction of an outdoor classroom and nature trail.

**Jackson County Council on Aging** - \$2,000 for the Senior Nutrition Site serving the Cashiers & Glenville areas

Spring 2008

**Summit Charter School** - \$7,000 of which \$4,000 helped purchase library and classroom equipment on their new campus and \$3,000 provided funding to purchase musical instruments for “Music in the Mountains” – an enrichment program for children throughout the Cashiers community.

Winter 2008

**Mountain Landscapes Initiative** - \$10,000 to support a mini-charrette addressing intelligent growth in Cashiers.

Fall 2007

**Animal Friends for Life** - \$7,000 toward expansion of the dog care facility.

**Blue Ridge Mountains Health Project** - \$7,000 to purchase equipment that sterilizes dental instruments at this Free Dental Clinic.

**The Village Conservancy, Inc.** - \$7,000 to begin construction of restrooms and a gift shop at the Village Green Park.

Spring 2007

**Blue Ridge School** - \$7,000 toward the student Interact Club’s project to develop a multi-purpose outdoor fitness center for the betterment of the community.

Fall 2006

**Jackson County Habitat for Humanity** - \$7,000 toward the purchase of a delivery truck to support the organization’s resale store located between Cashiers and Glenville, which will provide pick up and delivery service for furniture and appliances.

Spring 2006

**Community Care Clinic of Highlands-Cashiers** - \$25,000 toward starting a free clinic, staffed by volunteer doctors and nurses, to assist people who live and work in the area and lack the financial resources to access health services.

**Cashiers Historical Society** - \$3,000 to contract with a professional museum planner who will help the community develop a guide for innovative programming, and broader membership, marketing and fundraising for the Zachary-Tolbert House Museum.

Fall 2005

**Hampton School** - \$2,800 for the purchase of computer and digital camera equipment to enhance learning experiences for its students.

Spring 2005

**Blue Ridge Mountain Health Project, Inc.** - \$25,000 toward startup of a dental clinic to serve individuals without the resources to afford basic dental treatment.

**Summit Charter School Foundation** - \$1,000 toward the purchase of equipment to amplify teacher voices for hearing impaired students.

**Cashiers Historical Society** - \$1,000 toward the purchase of equipment and the support of an intern to create a digital catalogue of artifacts in the Zachary-Tolbert House Museum collection.

Fall 2004

**Jackson-Macon Conservation Alliance** - \$1,650 to purchase audio-visual equipment for making community presentations on important environmental issues like the Hemlock Woolly Adelgid problem facing Cashiers and the surrounding area.

Fall 2003

**Cashiers Historical Society** - \$15,000 to prepare a master site plan for the historic Zachary-Tolbert House. This master plan will address the future development of the Zachary-Tolbert House site while also preserving the historical integrity of the house and surrounding grounds.

Fall 2002

**Village Conservancy** - \$8,000 toward "Village Play," a community-wide project to design and build a playground in the town center.

Spring 2002

**Cashiers Valley Community Council** - \$5,500 to develop a plan for improving the facilities at the Cashiers Community Center.

Fall 2001

**Blue Ridge School** -- \$9,200 for development of an interactive school website to improve communication between teachers, students and parents in rural Jackson County.

Spring 2001

**Summit Charter School** -- \$4,200 to build a five-station science lab for sixth, seventh, and eighth grade students at this Jackson County school.

**Village Conservancy** -- \$5,500 to hire a part-time director for the newly renovated Zachary-Tolbert Historic House Museum in Cashiers.

Fall 2000

**Cashiers Area Humane Society** -- \$1,000 to provide spaying and neutering vouchers to pet owners in Cashiers.

**Village Conservancy** -- \$3,000 to build a walking path connecting the Village Green recreational facilities to the Cashiers Community Center complex.

Spring 1999

**Cashiers Valley Community Council** -- \$7,500 for a planning process to determine the feasibility of a capital campaign for a renovated or new community center to serve Cashiers area families.

**Glenville-Cashiers Rescue Squad** -- \$1,199 for purchase of a copier and projector to be used for teaching safety and rescue classes.

**Village Conservancy** -- \$2,400 for purchase of picnic tables for the Village Green town square in Cashiers.

Fall 1998

**Village Conservancy** -- \$5,000 to develop construction documents for the preservation of a significant 1850 Greek Revival home as an historic house museum in Cashiers.

Spring 1997

**Village Conservancy** -- \$1,000 to support a membership drive of the Cashiers Historical Society.

Fall 1996

**Blue Ridge School** -- \$350 to assist with Net Day '96, during which volunteers will install internet computer connections in the school.

**Glenville-Cashiers Rescue Squad** -- \$600 to purchase CPR mannequins for use in training volunteer rescue workers who serve the Cashiers community and surrounding area.

Spring 1996

**Blue Ridge School** -- \$500 to support "Dancing Drum: A Cherokee Legend"

**Cashiers Community Council, Inc.** -- \$500 for safety repairs and maintenance.

**Village Conservancy** -- \$1,000 to establish and expand this outdoor cultural park and greenway.

Spring 1995

**Hampton School** -- \$500 toward the purchase of educational computer equipment.

Spring 1994

**Child Development Center** - \$500 to purchase tricycles for the Center.

**Cashiers-Glenville Fire Department** - \$500 to purchase helmets for the firefighters.
